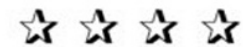

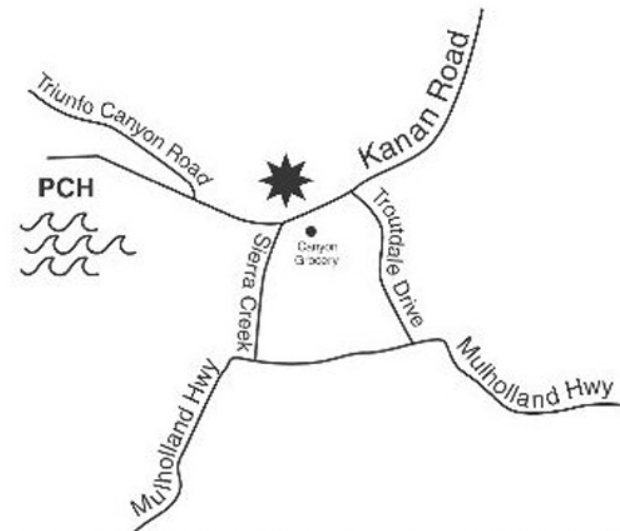

**USDF Membership Benefits:** USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and the promotion of the sport of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the USDF Directory or the USDF Web site at [www.usdf.org](http://www.usdf.org). To participate in a USEF/USDF-recognized competition as an owner/lessee or rider, you must either be a USDF Group, Intercollegiate/Interscholastic, or Participating Member, or have a USDF Non-Member Identification Number. (Note: Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their Business membership.) Exception: Handler in DSHB classes or riders and owners competing in classes which are exempt from USDF HID requirements.



**Participating Membership (PM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. Participating memberships are available for 1-year (\$62), 5-years (\$250), or life (\$1,000). A Youth Participating Membership is available for members under 21 (as of the start of the current membership year) for \$35. A Participating Membership allows the member to compete at USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner for all USDF Year-End Awards, Cosequin®/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals, and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The Group Membership year ends November 30. A Group Membership allows the member to compete at USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

**Intercollegiate/Interscholastic Membership (IM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Intercollegiate/Interscholastic Member Organization (IMO). The membership year is December 1 through November 30. An Intercollegiate/Interscholastic Membership allows the member to compete at USDF-recognized competitions, and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

**Non-Member Identification Number:** An individual with a Non-Member ID is not eligible for any USDF awards nor eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes, or Cosequin®/USDFBC Finals, or receive other USDF membership benefits. PMs, GMs, or IMs do not need a Non-Member ID to compete. The Non-Member number is downloadable from the USDF Web site, or USDF will print and mail a card for a \$10 fee.

**Business Membership:** A membership issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. There are two types of Business Membership: Standard (\$100) or Full (\$250). The Full Business Membership offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. Business Memberships satisfy requirements of horse ownership only. The membership year is December 1 through November 30.

#### USDF Horse Membership Defined

**\*\*\*Horses competing at USDF-recognized shows must have either a Horse Identification Number or a Lifetime Registration. Exception:** Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBC) at DSHB competitions, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (i.e. all Arabian, Friesian or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux, quadrille, or IPEC classes, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot and academy classes. For foreign owned horses competing in CDI class, USDF accepts copies of the horse identification pages from an FEI passport, or a completed HID application (with no fee requirements) in lieu of a USDF HID or Lifetime Registration number.

**Horse Identification Number (HID):** A one-time tracking number for horses (\$20). Scores earned by a horse with an HID will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Cosequin®/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals. An HID can be upgraded to a Lifetime Registration for a fee of \$45. If a horse is Lifetime Registered it does not need an HID. An HID does not need to be renewed.

**Lifetime Horse Registration:** A horse with a Lifetime Registration (\$65) is eligible for USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Cosequin®/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse is Lifetime Registered it does not need an HID. A Lifetime Registration does not need to be renewed.

*The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, received by the competition secretary.*

## RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

1. This show is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. **ENTRIES:** All entries close and must be postmarked by closing date. Correct fees and association numbers must accompany each entry form. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. No numbers will be issued without completed entries, full payment, signatures, fees and association numbers. Parents or guardians must sign entry blanks of minors.  
**LATE ENTRIES:** All entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date or will be subject to a late fee of \$25.00.  
**SCRATCHES:** Scratches made prior to the closing date will be refunded. It is the exhibitors responsibility to inform the office, (818) 735-4925 of their intention to scratch. There will be no refunds after the closing date.  
**POST ENTRIES:** Post entries will be accepted to fill scratches if the schedule permits. Horses already entered in the show will receive priority.  
**CHANGES:** All entry changes made after the closing date, at the request of the competitor, will be subject to a fee of \$25.00.  
**RETURNED CHECKS:** All checks returned by the bank will be charged an additional 10% penalty (\$25.00 minimum). Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full with cash or equivalent or they will be turned over to the USEF for further disciplinary action.
3. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at regular competitions, eventing competitions at the preliminary level or above and combined driving competitions at the advanced level, dressage, reining and vaulting competitions and endurance rides provided the respective breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at regular competitions, eventing competitions, dressage competitions, reining competitions and combined driving competitions upon payment of a \$20 non-member registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule; 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed reining competitions. Also exempted from this requirement are citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own national federation; 8) USEA beginner novice division; and 9) assistant handlers in dressage sport horse breeding classes. (See GR807.4 of the Federation rules.)**
4. **NON-MEMBERS FEES:** Senior USEF non-member fee is \$25, Junior non-members pay \$20. DASC members do NOT have to pay a CDS non-member fee. CDS members do NOT have to pay a DASC non-member fee. These fees apply per show.
5. **MINOR EXHIBITORS:** Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold SOUTHLAND FARM harmless for injury to such minor. No minor's entry will be accepted unless it is signed by a parent or guardian. The signatures of instructors, agents or other unrelated persons will not be acceptable.
6. **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Horse Show Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, it's Directors, and Employees, SOUTHLAND FARM, it's Directors and Employees, harmless for any loss or accident to his horse, horses or equipment which may occur from accident, sickness, fire or otherwise. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes, or to change officials as it deems necessary. The decision of Show Management is final.

MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of any incident in the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management and their decision will be final. The Horse Show Management reserves itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and to cancel award prizes, without claim to damage, to change, cancel or combine any classes, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, or to change rings or substitute officials. The judges decisions are strictly their own and the Management accepts absolutely no responsibility for those decisions.

7. ARENAS: All tests will be ridden in 20 x 60 meter sand arenas. Only those horses entered in the show are permitted use of the show facilities, warm-up arenas and show arenas. No one on foot is allowed in designated warm-up arenas. All horses in the sand warm-up arena must wear their competition numbers. All arenas must be vacated while equipment is being used. Horses are not to be left unattended in the arenas at any time.
8. CLOSED ARENAS: Horses are not permitted in competition arenas on a show day at any time other than scheduled riding times. VIOLATION will be cause for ELIMINATION.
9. LUNGEING: Absolutely no lungeing in the warm-up arenas. Lungeing in designated areas only.
10. RIDING TIMES: Times will be mailed to all exhibitors at the address provided on the entry blank. It is the riders responsibility to inform the management of any time conflicts at least 72 hours prior to the scheduled rides. Failure to enter the ring by the specified time will result in elimination from the class.
11. TESTS: Current USEF and FEI Tests will be ridden. FEI and USDF Musical Freestyles are offered.
12. 2006 GREAT AMERICAN/USDF QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS: In order to qualify for a Regional Championship, horse/rider combinations may qualify by earning a minimum of two qualifying scores at two official GREAT AMERICAN/USDF recognized competitions from two different judges in any region.
13. SCORED TEST: Tests will be given ONLY TO RIDERS or their agents and only after the class is placed. Check all scores upon receipt of test.
14. RIBBONS AND AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to fifth place in dressage classes. There will be High Point ribbons for Adult/Amateur, Junior, Open and FEI divisions for the show.
15. CANCELLATION: In the event of rain prior to the show, it is the responsibility of the rider to call the Management to determine whether the show is canceled. Shows are NOT canceled unless the footing deemed unsafe. If the show is canceled for any reason, a \$50.00 office fee will be retained from each entry and the balance refunded.
16. STABLING: Limited stalls with doors. Full service Friday-Sunday \$100, includes feeding, bedding and cleaning. Please call for availability.
17. PARKING: Parking of cars, truck and trailers is allowed in designated areas ONLY!
18. FOOD: Food will be available across the street from the grounds throughout the show.
19. DOGS: **ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS** will be permitted on the grounds.
20. No one under 21 may drive a golf cart.

#### ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, USEF) for horse, owner, rider and trainers, before the day(s) of competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.



## 2006 Great American Insurance Group/ USDF Regional Dressage Championships

A single Regional Dressage Championship program organized by the United States Dressage Federation (USDF), recognized by the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (USEF), will be held in each of the nine USDF regions. In addition, Alaska and Hawaii may each hold state championships if an official request from a GMO is received by April 1 of the prior year.

### Membership/Registration Requirements for Qualifying & Championships:

Rider:

- Must be a USDF Participating\* Member at the time qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships.
- Must be a USEF member (Junior, Senior, or Life) at the time the qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships.

Horse:

- Must be USDF Lifetime Registered at the time qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships. **Horse registration must be in the name(s) of the current "owner(s)" of record.** If a current lease recording is on file with USDF, the lessee is recognized as "owner" for all USDF membership requirements.
- Must be USEF (Annual or Lifetime) recorded at the time qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships. Horse registration must be in the name(s) of the current owner(s) or lessee(s) of record.
- Horse does not have to be breed registered.

Owner:

- Must be a USDF member (Participating or Business) at the time the qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships.
- Must be a USEF member (Junior, Senior, or Life) at the time qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships.

\*Participating Members are USDF members who join USDF directly

### 2006 Minimum Qualifying Scores

One set of nationally-standardized qualifying scores has been established for all USEF/USDF Regional Championships, for levels through Intermediate I, in three divisions: Open, Adult Amateur, and Junior/Young Rider. FEI Junior Rider and FEI Young Rider classes have only one respective division. Intermediate II, Grand Prix and freestyles have only Open divisions. The minimum percentages are as follows:
